



RESIDENTIAL SERVICE GUIDELINES

BULKY ITEMS

For an additional fee, Hardin Sanitation will pick up any large items that won't fit into your cart. Please call (208) 642-2629 at least 24 hours in advance of your normal collection day to schedule.

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

During the first 4 weeks in November (**only**), please set out your leaves in customer supplied Kraft paper bags. Leaves will be collected on your normal collection date.

CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Natural Christmas trees without lights, ornaments, tinsel, stands and flocking can be set out for collection the first two weeks after Christmas (**only**). Cut trees and branches into 4 foot pieces and place curbside by 7:00 am

Effective October 1, 2022 all residential waste in unincorporated Ada County must be contained within a garbage container provided by the County's waste collection contractor Hardin Sanitation.

Ada County Commissioners recently approved Ordinance No. 938, amending Ada County Code Title 5, Chapter 2 providing for the exclusive use of wheeled plastic carts available from the contractor.

For safety and efficiency, personal store-bought trash cans, boxes, plastic bags, bundled waste, and/or any other loose items will no longer be collected as part of your regular garbage service. These items need to be placed in a Hardin Sanitation cart.



Automated Waste Collection

Automated waste collection, using standard roll-out carts is a proven system that improves the work-life and safety of your local waste collection providers. To be fully automated, carts used for trash collection need to be standardized. Carts provided by the contractor are designed to be used with automatic truck "arms" which allow the truck to pick-up, dump, and replace carts at the curb easily. Below are just some of the added benefits:

- Wheeled carts with lids reduce windblown litter and helps control odor
- Reduces risk of worker injuries related to lifting and handling of waste
- Promotes safety, efficiency, and productivity
- Decreases worker's compensation claims and insurance costs
- Improves employee morale and retention.
- Contractor-provided carts are replaced at no charge when cracked or damaged by service trucks

Additional carts are available for a small monthly fee.

Other Important Reminders

- Place carts out for collection by 7:00 am on your scheduled pick up day
- All yard waste should be placed inside your regular trash cart
- All cardboard boxes should be broken down and placed inside your recycle cart
- Place carts in the street against the curb
- Place carts in area free of overhead trees, structures, utility lines etc. (14 feet clearance)
- Make sure cart handle faces your house, with cart opening toward the street
- Place used motor oil in clear jugs and in full view of drivers
